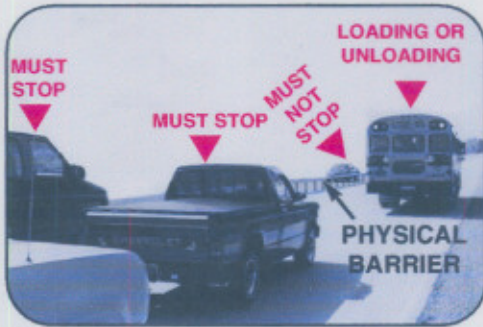

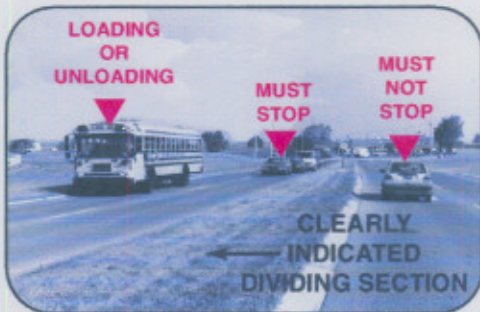
SEPARATE ROADWAYS

Drivers do not have to stop on a highway with clearly defined dividing sections or physical barriers providing separate roadways. This only applies when the school bus is on the opposite side of the road.

If In Doubt, STOP!



Physical barriers include concrete median barriers, metal median barriers, non-mountable curbs, guide rails, etc.



Clearly indicated dividing sections include concrete mountable curbs, trees or shrubs, rocks or boulders, a stream, grass, etc.

PENALTIES

If you are convicted of violating Pennsylvania's School Bus Stopping Law you will receive all of the following penalties:

- ◆ 60-Day Driver's License Suspension
- ◆ Five (5) points on your driving record
- ◆ \$250.00 Fine

The Consequences...

Annually over 1,000 motorists do not obey the School Bus Stopping Law.
